In conjunction with Nancy Hugo's talk about her book Seeing Trees on Jan. 26th at the Pitt County Agricultural Center, the GMA is proud to present photographer Robert Llewellyn.

Robert Llewellyn has been a professional photographer for over 40 years, and his detailed images of trees, buds, flowers, and leaves have gained much critical acclaim. In his life and work, he makes the distinction between "looking," which he considers passive, and "seeing," which is active. His entire body of work is infused with an enduring inquisitiveness about the way plants work and an accompanying sense of wonder.

The clarity of his hyper-real images engage the viewer with the beauty of the intricacy of nature. This is an exhibition any lover of nature or photography will not want to miss.
